The Higgins Branchini Shooting Foundation is hosting a Quail Hunt Fundraiser over two days to benefit collegiate shotgun shooters.



This year's event is being held at **Long Straw Ranch**, a 400-acre licensed game preserve in Forestburg, Texas, 1.5 hours north of Dallas and Ft. Worth, Texas.

Two quail hunts will be held on Friday morning and two more on Friday afternoon. On Saturday, two more hunts will be held in the morning and afternoon. Each hunting party will consist of a maximum of four hunters, so eight each morning and afternoon.

The cost is \$650 per person if paid by Oct. 12, 2017

The cost is \$750 per person if paid after Oct. 12, 2017

Entries include participation in the Quail Hunt, birds, guides, dogs, and bird cleaning. Lunch is also included and will be prepared by REATA RESTAURANTS on-site for all participants (Texas Cuisine). A raffle will be included.

HBSF grants to collegiate shooters help offset the expenses of training and competition, providing greater opportunities for recipients to hone their skills and compete at venues that might otherwise be out of reach. In our first six years, nearly 100 shooters from across the country received grants totaling \$125,000; several of them have gone on to win national collegiate and international championships and qualified to represent the U.S. in various international shotgun championships.
